Dear Ma'am:

When I was in Court on January 29, 2008, at the Settlement Conference, the Judge told me to send her a letter with some specific information in it by February 5, 2008. After stating that due date, the Judge then said that she would find an attorney who would speak to me about my case. At that point, the Judge extended the due date of my letter to February 15, 2008. It is, therefore, my assumption that the reason the deadline was extended those 10 days was in order for me to have an opportunity to speak to a lawyer before sending that letter as well as any other information to the Court. Approximately one week after January 29, 2008, when I had not yet heard from the Court about having a lawyer appointed to me, I contacted the Court and asked what the status was of finding a lawyer to help me. I was told on that date, that a lawyer had not yet been located. I was also told that I would be appointed a lawyer, and I would be contacted when one had been appointed.

I would, respectfully, therefore ask for an extension of the February 15, 2008, due date for filing the letter that the Judge requested, as well as an extension in filing initial disclosures, etc., until I have had an opportunity to meet with a lawyer.

Thank you very much for your attention to this matter. On today's date, I have sent a copy of this letter to attorney for the Plaintiffs, Mr. John Bauer.
